6. Type of moraine found along the center of a glacier, formed when two glaciers join, their lateral moraines meeting to form the central band of debris.
7. A term which describes a moraine that is formed where a glacier reaches its farthest extent before beginning to retreat.
8. Material carried directly by a glacier.
9. Ridges built up by deposits carried by streams flowing under glacial ice.
10. A deep, amphitheatre-shaped basin found on a glaciated mountain.
