- 7. Cud-chewing mammal used as a draft or saddle animal in desert regions.
- 8. Supplying dry land with water by means of ditches etc.
- 9. Having a habit of seeking food or moving about at night; as, nocturnal birds and insects.
- 10. Any spiny succulent plant of the family Cactaceae native chiefly to arid regions of the New World.
